APPOINTMENT OF THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL'S MANAGING DIRECTOR

The current Director of Development Services, Mr. Rob Thomas was appointed as the Managing Director. There were a number of internal and external applications.

NEW COUNCIL SERVICE CHARGES FROM 1ST APRIL 2015 – INFORMATION FROM THE VALE OF GLAMORGAN COUNCIL

Bulky Item Collection. The charge for this service will be £15.00 per 3 items, with additional items charged at £5.00 each, up to a maximum of 5 items. Residents will still be able to take bulky items to either of the two Household Recycling Centres in the Vale.

Kitchen Waste Bags. During April residents will receive an annual supply of biodegradable kitchen waste bags; this supply will allow for 3 full kitchen waste caddies per week. Any additional biodegradable bags required can be purchased from the council at £2.00. Alternatively residents can line their caddy with newspaper.

Blue Dog Waste Bags. These will be charged at £1.00 for a roll of 50 bags.
