

## **COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT – FEBRUARY 2017**

### **CROSS COMMON ROAD JUNCTION**

We understand that the new road and junction will be officially opened 'sometime soon'. We regret to say that an exact date is not known. Colleagues will be aware that a number of Councillors met with Councillor Peter King Cabinet Member for this scheme regarding the potential implications for highway network including Longmeadow Drive. ### **FURNITURE DONATION**

The Vale of Glamorgan Council has teamed up with The Place For Homes Furniture Store in Llandow to offer free sofas and chairs to those most in need within the County.

More than 15 brand new sofas were selected for distribution, to those in that situation, through the Vale Council's Housing Department. They are being delivered free by The Place for Homes, at the beginning of next week. All the sofas and chairs on offer were brand new, meeting all relevant fire regulations.

This initiative is ongoing and discussions have already begun to provide dining furniture, beds and bedroom furniture to those that need it in the future.

### **TRANSPORT STUDY**

**The Vale of Glamorgan Council with Welsh Government has agreed to fund a Study to explore the transport network issues and opportunities for Dinas Powys.**

The money will be spent on analysing the Village's current transport network, with the aim of identifying any issues with it and ways they might be resolved. Discussions between Vale Council Officers and Welsh Government Officials have been taking place on this subject for a number of weeks.

It has now been decided that a Study into the transport network issues and opportunities in Dinas Powys will be carried out over the coming months with funding for the Study coming from both parties. The cost of the Study will be approximately £15,000.
