

COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT – NOVEMBER 2014

ST. CYRES SCHOOL

The School has been relocated to the new building. The old buildings will be demolished and new sports pitches created. The School building is magnificent and well worth a visit.

SAFETY WORK – DINAS POWYS TO BARRY

The erection of additional signage and warnings along the main road has commenced.

REGIONALISING REGULATORY SERVICES

The Vale Council is planning to merge Regulatory Services with Cardiff and Bridgend. The aim is to make substantial financial savings. The main focus of the savings appears to be reducing staffing levels. The service includes the inspection of food premises.

THE FORMER ST. CYRES ANNEXE, DINAS POWYS

The site is now being marketed with potential developers being requested to produce a master plan. There are no details regarding the traffic implications to date. The Vale Council will select a preferred bidder based on a combination of price and community interest. Subsequently a planning application will have to be submitted.

CARDIFF ROAD, DINAS POWYS

A collapsing road gully near the junction with Powys Place requires urgent repair which is likely to take place this week. Traffic signals will be required. The implications for traffic congestion are obvious.
