

COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT – JUNE 2015

DEPOSIT LOCAL GOVERNMENT PLAN

The Cabinet has published the response to the Public Consultation process. Despite around 3,000 comments the plan has been barely amended. The projected numbers of houses required by the plan remains excessively high and cannot be justified by the available facts. We have opposed the Plan at the Planning Committee. The public will be able to make comment in person at the Environment Scrutiny Committee Meeting on Tuesday 16th June at 6.00 p.m. in the Civic Offices by arrangement in advance.

ST CYRES SCHOOL

The pupil numbers are starting to show signs of growth with more pupils joining the school each year. This will have a positive impact on the School's finances. A small surplus is projected for the year 2015/16

ALLOTMENTS

There is a waiting list of 900 for allotments across the Vale. Despite this demand an application by Sully Community Council to provide plots near Beechwood College, Hayes Road, Sully was rejected.

CITY REGION

A major announcement is being made today regarding the potential creation of a 'City Region' including Cardiff and surrounding areas. Details are awaited.
