

COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT - JULY 2014

CROSS COMMON BRIDGE

The County Council has published a proposal to replace the Cross Common Road Bridge with a new road that avoids the stream. There has not been a Cabinet Report which hopefully would provide firm details, a time table or an estimate. Negotiations we understand are taking place with the land owner to facilitate this latest proposal.

FINANCES

The County has been warned to expect a cut of 4 to 5% in financial support from the Welsh Government. However, currently the finances of the council are sound. The process will be underway shortly for next year's budget.

ST CYRES SCHOOL

The building work is on track for handover to the school as per the timetable for opening a little after autumn half term.

LIBRARY PROPOSALS

There has not been an update by the Cabinet regarding the future of Dinas Powys Library. We may wish to express our concern regarding the uncertainty surrounding the provision of Library Services to Cabinet and also the Lifelong Learning Scrutiny Committee.
