MEDICAL CENTRE

Members will be aware that there is a Public Exhibition regarding the proposed Medical Centre at St. Cyres Site on 18 June 3.00 pm–8.00 pm in the Lee Hall. This is organised jointly by the Health Board and the Developer.

WORLD ENVIRONMENT DAY

CYCLEWAY

It is interesting that there are widespread objections to the £250,000 cycleway through lower Penarth yet the Vale does not seem interested in providing an essential route off the highway from Dinas Powys to Barry. We suggest that the Community Council renews the request for a path/cycleway that will provide safe access to the west of Dinas Powys.

CCTV

There is a proposal to relocate the CCTV Centre covering the Vale to Bridgend. Apparently the cost will be around £150,000 in relocation charges. Staffing levels have already been reduced in the Vale.

PUBLIC TRANSPORT

Cardiff Bus has published its new time table which will adversely affect residents. Instead of 3 buses per hour on the 95 Service it is proposed that this be reduced to two per hour. As this affects services to Llandough Hospital it could inconvenience patients and Hospital visitors.
