

## **COUNTY COUNCILLORS REPORT JUNE 2014**

### **LIBRARY CHANGES**

The Life Long Learning Committee considered the Cabinet's report on proposed changes to the library service. There were representations from staff representatives, local councillors and comments from the Leader and the relevant Cabinet member. The proceedings of the committee will be forwarded to the Cabinet.

Also committee recommended that charges for library services are increased with immediate effect in line with a range of services. The Cabinet was also urged to seek other income generation and grant funding opportunities. We await the outcome of such discussions.

### **PROPOSAL TO AMALGAMATE CARDIFF ROAD INFANTS SCHOOL/MURCH JUNIOR SCHOOL**

The joint governing bodies meeting took place this week to discuss the proposed amalgamation.

### **SULLY ROAD RESURFACING**

The Vale is proposing to resurface a length of Sully Road south of the junction with Cross Common Road. There are on going discussions regarding the exact details.

### **ST CYRES SITE**

The construction of the buildings is proceeding apace. The impressive theatre is taking shape and at present the site will be handed over to the two schools in time for the programmed move over Half Term 2014.
