Mill Road resurfacing

We are delighted after years of campaigning a section of Mill Road has been substantially resurfaced. Not as much as we wanted but good progress. We constantly struggle to get the Vale Council to carry out vital maintenance work on local roads and pavements.

Improved lighting at stations

Access to local stations has been poorly lit and so we mounted a campaign to improve matters. Now the new lighting has made a huge difference.

Benches

Due to a substantial grant from The Vale / S106 funds the benches on the common and elsewhere are being renewed

Replacement Local Development Plan

We are continuing to voice our concerns with the Vale proposals to impose nearly 2,000 new properties in our community. There's no commitment to provide additional community facilities, public transport or an explanation how the roads will cope. The Health Board is not offering extra medical services. Many local schools are full. Where will it end?
