89. Declaration of Interests

90. To Confirm Minutes of the Full Council Meeting held on 19 October 2023

91. Matters Arising from Full Council Minutes held on 16 November 2023

Item 79 (item 71e) County Councillor's Report – Traffic Lights Merrie Harrier

Traffic lights were back in working order, however, VOG Highways attended an RTC on 12/12/23 where a HGV mounted the traffic island and struck the traffic light column. Street Lighting are aware of this incident and works to install a new column are being programmed.

a) School Budgets

School budgets are in a terrible situation. VOG are waiting to hear back from Welsh Government next week regarding the budget for Local Governments.

Replacement Local Development Plan
