Thanks for the information. This has been happening the last few years though, £1 per hour per year.

I know prices have increased etc and this is no offence to the Parish.

I do think if it keeps increasing, people may look elsewhere which would be awful as the halls are lovely. The most I pay at other halls is £10 per hour so it's a big difference.

And especially with clients who have been with the Parish for years. I've been since Mike was the clerk and have spent over £30,000 at the hall. There's nothing for loyal clients?

Thanks for your message.

I booked the use of Lee Hall for the whole of this year (one Saturday a month) back in February 2023. At the time the rent was £13 an hour.

I accepted the rent increase in June last year (to £14 an hour) as I accept that we live in challenging times with regards to rising costs.

I am running a 3-year diploma course for yoga teachers, with just 7 students. The fees for the course were set in September 2021. I cannot increase my prices, so am unable to pass on the rent increase.

The course comes to a completion in November this year, so I wonder if the committee would consider maintaining the rent at the current rate for the duration?
