Dear Sir/Madam,

I am writing to request permission to use Dinas Powys Common as a venue for Dinas Powys Football Club's annual mini and junior football festival. The event is scheduled to take place on Saturday 14th June 2025 between the hours of 8.30am and approximately 6pm.

The event will take place over 2 separate sessions (morning and afternoon). I predict that there will be approximately 200 children taking part and approximately 400 spectators for each session.

It is the intention of Dinas Powys Football Club's Festival Committee that some of the land to the right of the rugby club (looking from St Andrews Road) will be organised into mini football pitches and will provide space for a small selection of food and beverage stalls.

As a club, DPFC would like to stress that it will be a priority to ensure that no harm or damage is caused to the environment before, during or after the event. DPFC will ensure that bins are positioned around the perimeter of the proposed pitches, these will be replaced, if necessary, throughout the day by volunteers, and will be collected and disposed of properly, along with any dropped litter at the end of the event. We will also ensure that the Wild Meadow is not disturbed during the preparation of the ground and on the day of the event.

As with previous events that have taken place on the Common in recent years, DPFC intends to use the land to the left of the rugby club (looking from St Andrews Road) as a facility for car parking. This will be organised safely (we will have parking stewards on site throughout the day), and with the utmost consideration for local residents and the environment.
