DAMAGE TO CAERLEON PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT

As you will be aware the Council have the responsibility of looking after the Caerleon Playground. The Council acquired this on a 25-year lease to help the residents and their children in the area. Sadly, the playground has been vandalised on several occasions. The most recently within the last week. The Community Council cannot afford to finance repairs on an ongoing arrangement

We would ask you to be vigilant. If you see anyone causing damage to the play equipment please call 999 immediately and report the matter. You can also call 101 (South Wales Police non-emergency line) if you find any damaged equipment and or report the matter ideally with photographs to the Clerk's office. Details above.

We, as a Community Council, appreciate the goodwill and support we receive from our local residents. The play park is for the benefit of all, and we depend on you to help us keep our play areas safe and enjoyable places for our children to play and meet new and old friends. However, we are very concerned that if the Park cannot be adequately safe-guarded, it may be necessary to consider its future.
