

From the 6th April 2024 the Welsh Government is introducing new regulations that will require all workplaces to separate recyclable materials in the same way that most house holders do now. This will improve the quality and quantity of how waste is collected and separated.

How will this effect Dinas Powys Community Council?

The following materials will need to be separated and collected separately:

- **Paper and card**
- **Metal, plastic** (cartons and other fibre-plastic packaging.)

How can Dinas Powys Community prepare for this change?

Maxine has informed all the regular hirers about the change and updated all the terms and conditions which have been updated around the halls.



We have purchased these stackable separated bins, which have already been set up in each hall – which are clearly labelled. This will encourage our hirers and make it easier to separate.

We have organised with Biffa to purchase black bags which are solely for metal and plastic which is the cheaper option then purchasing another bin.



Cemetery /allotment is currently still general waste, we are looking to get another lock on the large bin as at the moment as we are having a problem with people fly tipping.
